If she had called two weeks ago, she may have gotten her as a client."

Don't just stay in touch with people because you know they are a potential client. But allow their iron to sharpen your iron. "Reconnect because we all need great people in our lives. We don't need quantity or more people in our lives. It's amazing how many people can be in our lives, with social media and the Internet. But what we need are the greatest of the great . . . the really good people . . . the ones we really need to embrace and keep close forever."


